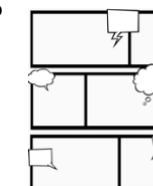

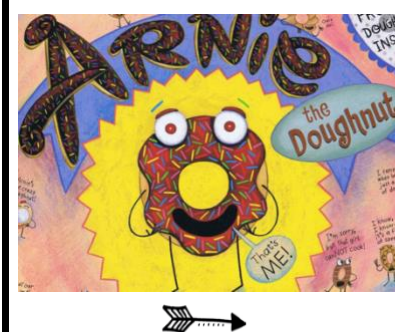
Click the picture to listen to the traditional story 'Jack and the Beanstalk'.

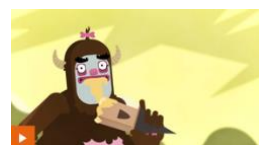


Weekly Writing Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

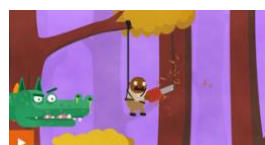
