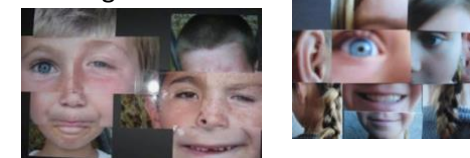

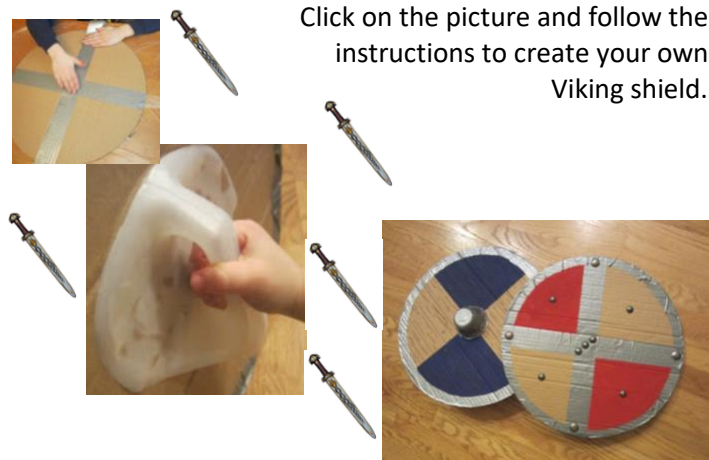

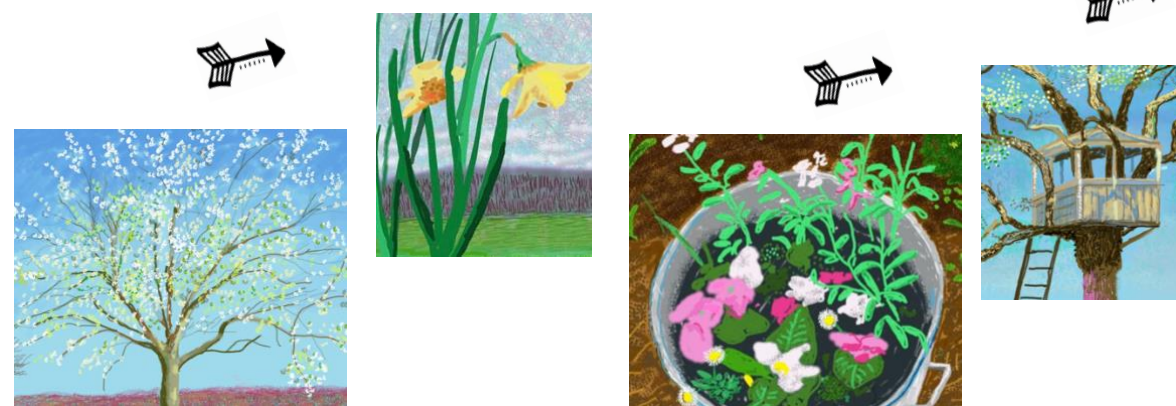
#### Viking Alphabet

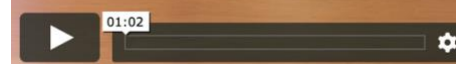
#### TEENY TINY TWIG RAFTS!
