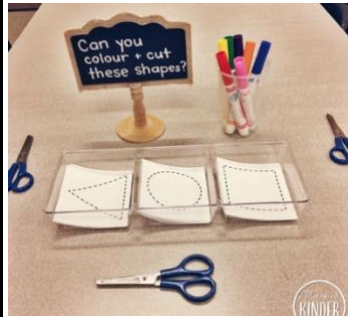

Weekly Maths Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

Colour and cut the shapes!



Make some shapes for your child to colour and cut out like the ones above!

Can your child name the shapes?

Can they create a picture using the shapes they have coloured and cut out?

Introduce number bonds!



Think about what number calculations using the **part, part, whole model** above.

The two bottom circles add together to make the total at the top. Have a go at home!

Double Numbers!



Use finger painting and paper to practise doubles!

Fold your paper and see the spots double. Can your child count how many spots there are now the number has been doubled?

Get creative with your pictures!

How tall or how small?



Use cubes to compare how tall and how small objects are around the house.

Can you create a table with your results in to share via seesaw?

Lego Time!



Use Lego to get to grips with numbers.

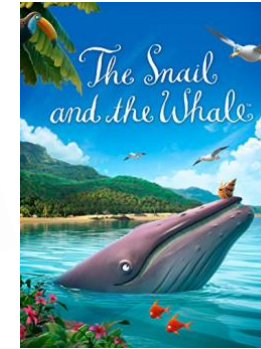
Can you create a grid like the one in the picture and ask your child to arrange the Lego in the correct column?

Weekly Creative Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

Snail Race!

Can you create your own race track? And have a snail race with your partner? Blow through the straw to move your cotton snail faster!



Fill up a bowl, sink or basin and provide your child with a range of objects to explore. What objects float and which sink? Ask them why they think they float/sink?

CHALLENGE:

Can you make an object that floats? You could use tin foil, paper or even leaves from the garden! **How many pennies can it hold?**



Make your own 'Under the Sea' Scene

Can you use junk modelling or craft items you have around your house to create the scene? You could even add in natural objects e.g. grass as seaweed.
