Literal: Where did Cyril live?

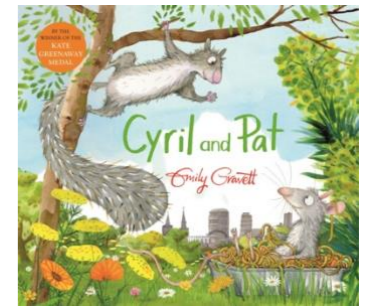
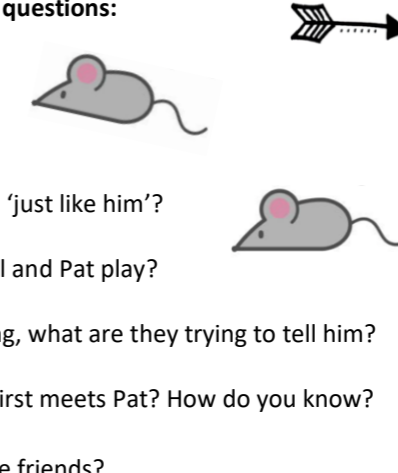
Inference: Why do you think Cyril thought Pat was 'just like him'?

You must use each character once: Cyril, Pat and Slim.

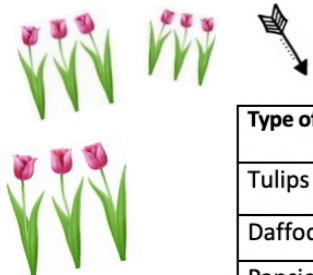
Example	Character
