 Will the penguin play with a kite again?



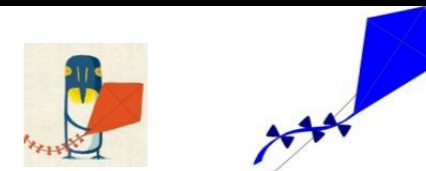
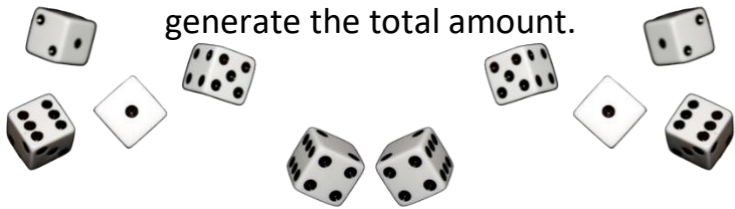
Story Telling

When listening to the story can you spot any rhyming words? Shout them out so your grown up can write them down!

Look at another car registration, either your parents/carers or someone who lives next door. What do the numbers total in their registration? What's the difference between the one above and the one you've identified on your street? What's the highest total you can find on a car registration?

Who has the biggest hands in your family?

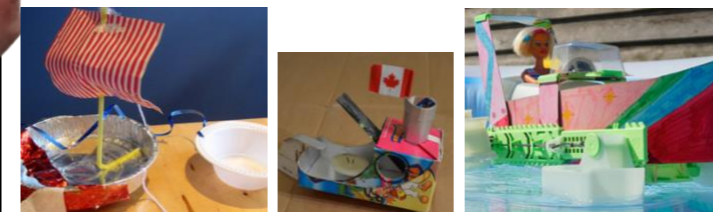
How did you find out?
