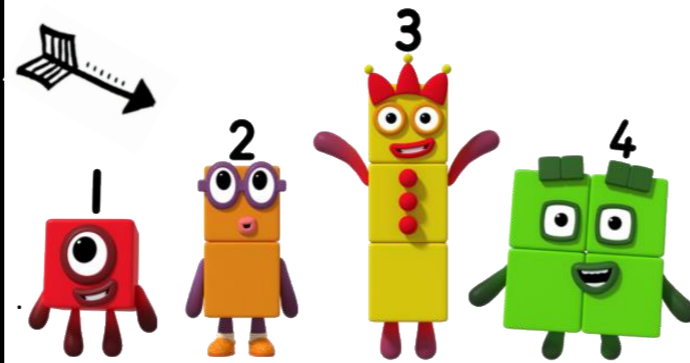


Weekly Maths Tasks (aim to do 1 per day)

This week's learning is going to be based around **Number Blocks from CBeebies!** Click the links to try the quizzes- enjoy!



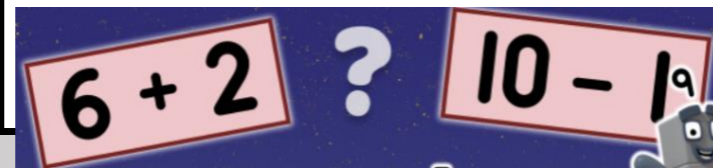
Who has more?

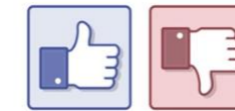

Weekly Literacy Tasks (aim to do 1 per day)

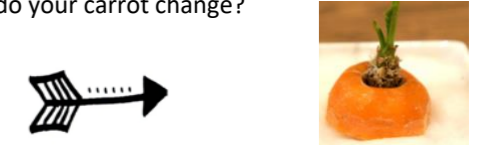
Crunchy VEG

Can you try a new vegetable every day? Which one is your favourite? Which do you not like?



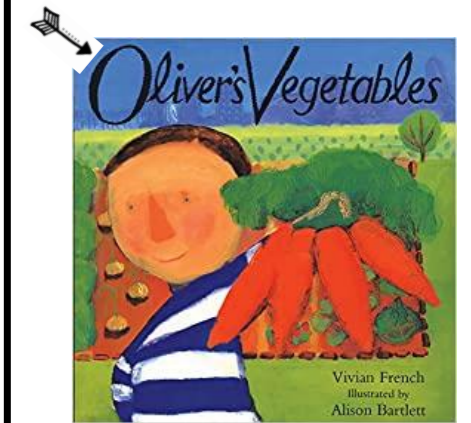
Carrot Growing

What changes? Can you make a diary and draw what you see every day? How do your carrot change?



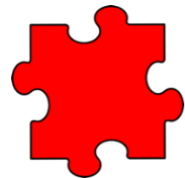
STORY MAP

Jigsaw Puzzle



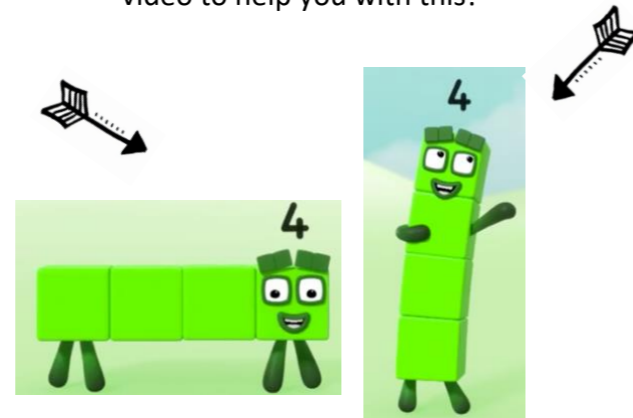
Click on the [link](#) to play the jigsaw puzzle game. You will be asked what level of challenge you would like to play.. Can you try one at each level?

Can you create a fact file with as much information about the number 4? What do you know? Use the video to help you with this!

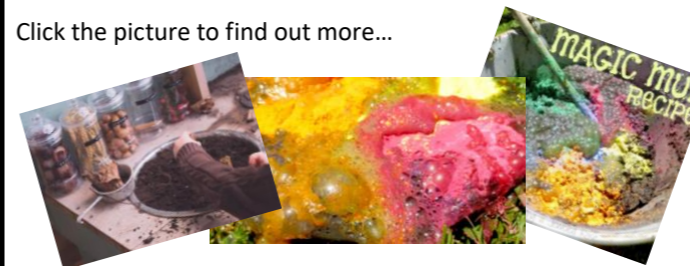


Mud Kitchen
