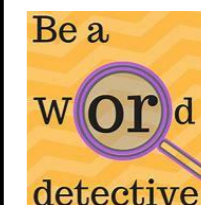
Literal: What happened on the 15th April 12:45am?

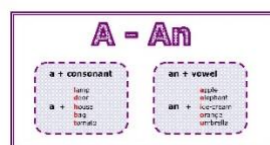

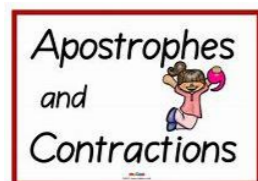

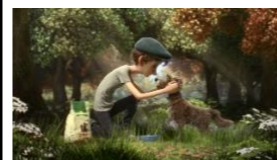


Click the picture and watch the news report 'Our Planet'
